

INITIATE

Ways to initiate:

1.Hero Care App 2.Call:1-877-272-7337 3. Redcross.org 4.Your Local Red Cross

INFO

Provide:

- Name
- -Rank
- -Rirthday
- -Emergend
 - -LPOC

VERIFY

The Red Cross will verify the emergency.

DELIVER

The Red Cross will then deliver the emergency communication message to the command.

FOLLOW-UP

We will follow-up after the message has been delivered.
